GUIDED EXMOOR WALKING WEEKENDS

The walks are suitable for regular walkers and a degree of stamina is necessary.

The breaks are as follows:-

Arrive Friday, (a short afternoon walk is available for anyone arriving by lunch-time, but check in time into your bedroom is not until after 3.00 pm), walk Saturday and Sunday and then depart for home in the afternoon.

The special rate of £220.00 per person for the 2 nights includes:-

- Half board accommodation for 2 nights.
- Guided walks on 2 or 3 days.
- Transport as required to and from walks.
- Packed lunch.
- Tea and coffee thermos flask filling if required.
- Use of drying facilities if needed.
